### MISSION

The Capacity Development Plan (CDP) of Jaluit Atoll Local Government (JALG) is a three-year plan to be executed in Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 – 2023, to achieve a local standard in the practice of Climate Change Disaster Risk Management to address the adverse impacts of climate change in Jaluit Atoll's island communities.

### GOAL

The CDP aims to provide a feasible strategy to enhance community resilience, incorporating sustainable developments and traditional knowledge.

### OBJECTIVE

The CDP identifies the required training needs and the focus areas on the specific skills and knowledge required, the institutions (formal and informal) that can provide the trainings, funding sources and a timeline to engage and successfully complete these trainings in three years (2020 – 2023)
